- He needs feedback from students to create a new SFCC
- Signing Agreements
 - No major problems, besides Secretary Kofahl having multiple questions
- Movie Night
 - Event will be held outside, (If the weather does not permit will be in the student commons), on September 7th, 2022
 - The three movies that were debated were *Monster University*, *Breakfast Club*, and *Highschool Musical*
 - A motion was made to approve *High School Musical* and it passed with unanimous support
